

## List of competent authorities and their areas of responsibility - The Netherlands

	Authority	The authority's area of responsibility
1	The Consumer and Market Authority	The ACM is responsible for fair competition between businesses, and protects consumer interests.
2	The Financial Markets Authority	Supervising the operation of the financial markets.
3	The Personal Data Authority	Supervising the processing of personal data in order to ensure compliance with laws that regulate the use of personal data.
4	The Nederlandsche Bank N.V.	Safeguarding financial stability.
5	The House for Whistleblowers (the Dutch Whistleblowers Authority)	Providing advice and support for employees who want to report a possible wrongdoing within their organization.
6	The Health and Youth Care Inspectorate	Supervising healthcare and youth care services in the Netherlands and the international market for medicines and medical devices.
7	The Dutch Healthcare Authority	Monitoring the conduct of care providers and insurance companies.
8	The Nuclear Safety and Radiation Protection Authority	Ensuring that the highest standards of nuclear safety and radiation protection are met in the Netherlands.
9	Organisations and administrative bodies, or parts thereof, appointed by order in council or ministerial regulation, that have tasks or powers in one of the areas listed in Article 2 (1) of the Directive
